

THE KINGS ANOINTING

⁸ *Who has ever heard of such things? Who has ever seen things like this? Can a country be born in a day or a nation be brought forth in a moment? Yet no sooner is Zion in labor than she gives birth to her children.*

Isaiah 66:8

²⁴ *But if an unbeliever or an inquirer comes in while everyone is prophesying, they are convicted of sin and are brought under judgment by all, ²⁵ as the secrets of their hearts are laid bare. So they will fall down and worship God, exclaiming, "God is really among you!"*

I Corinthians 14:24-25

I. Christ was Prophet (Deuteronomy 18:15), Priest (Psalm 110:4), and King (Deuteronomy 17:15; Isaiah 9:6).

[Deu 18:15 NIV] ¹⁵ *The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him.*

[Psa 110:4 NIV] ⁴ *The LORD has sworn and will not change his mind: "You are a priest forever, in the order of Melchizedek."*

[Deu 17:15 NIV] ¹⁵ *be sure to appoint over you a king the LORD your God chooses. He must be from among your fellow Israelites. Do not place a foreigner over you, one who is not an Israelite.*

[Isa 9:6 NIV] ⁶ *For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.*

A. All three anointings were simultaneously upon him.

B. These anointings rest now, corporately, upon the body of Christ.
(I John 4:17)

¹⁷ *This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: In this world we are like Jesus.*

II. Nine gifts / Three sets of three (I Corinthians 12:8-11)

⁸ *To one there is given through the Spirit a message of wisdom, to another a message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, ⁹ to another faith by the*

same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit,¹⁰ to another miraculous powers, to another prophecy, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues.¹¹ All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he distributes them to each one, just as he determines.

- A. Prophetic anointing - Vocal gifts. Tongues, interpretation of tongues, prophecy.
- B. Priestly anointing - Power gifts. Healing, working of miracles, faith.
- C. Kings anointing - Revelation gifts. Word of wisdom. word of knowledge, discerning of spirits.

IV. Five characteristics of the kings anointing

- A. The kings anointing involves exact words of truth. (Proverbs 16:10)

¹⁰ The lips of a king speak as an oracle, and his mouth does not betray justice.

- B. The kings anointing involves flexibility. (Proverbs 21:1)

¹ In the LORD's hand the king's heart is a stream of water that he channels toward all who please him.

- C. The kings anointing involves discerning of spirits. (Proverbs 20:8)

⁸ When a king sits on his throne to judge, he winnows out all evil with his eyes.

* naming, identifying, and then expelling evil in our midst.

- D. The kings anointing involves holiness. (Proverbs 20:28)

²⁸ Love and faithfulness keep a king safe; through love his throne is made secure.

* loyalty, faithfulness, maturity, balance, and teamwork

- E. The kings anointing involves strategies for warfare. (Proverbs 20:18)

¹⁸ Plans are established by seeking advice; so if you wage war, obtain guidance.

* cross pollination and cooperation for the first global awakening

V. A gift of naming / Kingly discernment has an eye to discriminate between what things are, versus what they appear to be.

* Gold, Silver, Oil, Wine, Pearls, Pots, Gems, Honey, Bread, Ashes
